



- 1 Remove cover of the frame.



- 2 Put both sides of the frame simultaneously inside insert



3 Assemble D+E on both sides



4 Slide cover over the frame down to the bottom

5 Attach velcro on the other side on the back







6 Open the harness by pressing the sides of the buckle

KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE

WARNING

Fall Hazard: Babies have suffered skull fractures falling while in and from bouncers.

- Use bouncer **ONLY** on floor.
- **NEVER** lift or carry baby in bouncer.

Suffocation Hazard: Babies have suffered when bouncers tipped over on soft surfaces.

- **NEVER** use on a bed, sofa, cushion, or other soft surface.
- **NEVER** leave baby unattended.

To prevent **falls** and **suffocation**:

- **ALWAYS** use restraints and adjust to fit snugly, even if baby fall asleep.
- **STOP** using bouncer when baby starts trying to sit up or has reached 20lb / 9kg, whichever comes first.



SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. **WARNING!** Never leave the child unattended.
2. **WARNING:** Do not use the bouncer once your child can sit unaided.
3. **WARNING:** This bouncer is not intended for prolonged periods of sleeping.
4. **WARNING:** It is dangerous to use this bouncer on an elevated surface e.g. a table.
5. **WARNING:** Always use the restraint system.
6. **WARNING:** Do not let children play with this product.
7. **WARNING:** Do not move or lift this product with the baby inside.
8. This bouncer does not replace a cot or bed. If your child needs to sleep, then he should be placed in a suitable cot or bed.
9. **WARNING!** Do not use this infant bouncer seat if it is damaged or broken.
10. **WARNING!** Do not use the product if any part is broken, torn or missing. Do not use spare parts other than those approved by the manufacturer.
11. Additional or replacement parts should be obtained from Childhome.
12. The manufacturer's warranty is not transferable and may therefore only be invoked by the first owner.
13. This bouncer is suitable for children aged up to 9 months and a max. weight of 9 kg/20lbs.
14. **WARNING!** Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the product
15. **WARNING!** To avoid danger of suffocation remove plastic cover before using this article. This cover shall be destroyed or kept away from children.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE RECOMMENDATION

18. To wash the fabric seat, loosen the velcro strip at the bottom and pull it off the frame.
19. Wash separately at 30°C. Do not tumble-dry.
20. Clean the frame and base by wiping with a damp cloth.
21. Do not use corrosive products.
22. Solid wood furniture can change slightly in its appearance during use: sunlight can alter the colour, while fluctuations in atmospheric humidity can affect the surface treatment. However this does not affect the value, functionality or service life of the furniture.
